Data Protection Notice – European Masonic Association

Your data

This notice is for all candidates and Freemasons of *the European Masonic Association (EMA)*. It applies to the processing of your personal data by EMA.

Section I sets out the purposes for which your data will be used by EMA if you are a candidate. Section II sets out the purposes for which your data will be used by EMA if you are a member.

Section I. Use of your data during your application to become a member of EMA As a candidate for EMA, you consent to the processing, retention and sharing of your personal data for the purpose of assessing your membership application and any other Masonic applications you may make.

You can withdraw your consent and request erasure of your data at any time prior to your ratification by notifying your proposer and seconder that you wish to cancel your application.

Section II. Use of your data after you become a member of EMA

As a member of EMA your data will be processed, retained and shared for any reasonable purposes required by the By-Laws or the bodies it sanctions from time to time. These purposes include, but are not limited to, the following:

- 1. Registering you as a member of EMA;
- 2. Processing communications you send to or receive from EMA;
- 3. Processing your involvement in any EMA visits you choose to register for and participate in.

You may stop your data from being used by EMA by resigning in the usual manner.
